#### Yearly/Monthly Tuition Payments:

- 1. Yearly Plan: Tuition may be paid in full prior to the first day in class to receive a 10% discount.
- Monthly Plan: Tuition is paid in 10 equal monthly payments due by the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month from August through May. Voucher co-payments to be paid within the first 6 months of the beginning of school year.

Returning students receive a discounted Registration Fee for registering early (see below). This fee includes: (1) Textbooks, (2) Workbooks, (3) Library Fee, (4) Student Insurance.

- 3. There will be a \$30.00 charge for each returned check.

## **RJA Internet Acceptable Use Policy/Media Release**

We believe that technology is a vital means to assist those who carry out the educational ministry of Ramah Junior Academy.

#### Internet Rules:

Students are responsible for good behavior on school computer networks just as they are in a classroom or a school hallway. Communications on the network are often public in nature.
